



Patron-Taught Craft Classes @ Saline County Library

Saline County Library is accepting class proposals from artisans and craftsmen eager to teach a class for people interested in a new hobby or craft.

The Library will decide which submissions to accept, and accepted applicants will be notified for scheduling. Each accepted applicant will be awarded \$100 to teach two (Bob Herzfeld Memorial Library & Mabel Boswell Memorial Library), two-hour classes and the supplies, within reason, will be provided by the Library. A maximum number of attendees for the classes will be set.

Craft classes have been taught at the Library in the past, but there are many crafts that have not been included. Priority will be given to those crafts that have not been taught previously, but a different pattern or style is certainly acceptable as a submission.
